KUORTANE AND SEINÄJOKI

The Organizing Committee warmly welcomes you to the FISU World University Championship Golf which will be held on 27th – 30th of August 2024 in Kuortane and Seinäjoki in the Western Region of Finland.

The Championship Event Center/Athletes' Village will be located at Kuortane Olympic Training Center. It is the same venue, where 2008 World University Floorball Championship, 2012 World University Wrestling Championship and 2018 World University Orienteering Championship were successfully arranged.

Kuortane is a small, lively municipality in Southern Ostrobothnia with an area of 485 km2 and a population of about 3.500. Kuortane is set in a peaceful countryside environment on an idyllic lakeside. Kuortane is proven to be one of the safest surroundings in Finland. The village is best known for the Olympic Training Center and the Sports High School.

Seinäjoki is the centre of South Ostrobothnia and one of the fastest growing urban areas in Finland. Seinäjoki 's population is about 65.000. Formed by nine municipalities, the urban area of Seinäjoki has a population of about 150,000.

Seinäjoki offers high-quality education from comprehensive school to university level as well as good employment opportunities and, as Finland's sixth largest market area, very competitive and attractive commercial services.

Seinäjoki is well known for its unique administrative and cultural centre, The Aalto Centre, designed by the architect and academic Alvar Aalto, as well as for its summer events e.g. Provinssi, Solar Sound, Tangomarkkinat, and Vauhtiajot.

PARTICIPANTS

All athletes must satisfy the following conditions:

- a) Be a national of the country they represent.
- **b)** Be at least 18 and no older than 25 years of age on the 31 December of the year of the event, for 2024, athletes must be born between the 01/01/1999 and the 31/12/2006.
- c) Athletes participating in FISU sport events must represent the same country as in their respective International Federations events. Changes of sport nationality must follow respective IF rules.

Only the following may participate as athletes in a FISU World University Championship:

- a) Students who are currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at a university or similar institute whose status is recognised by the appropriate national academic authority of their country.
- **b)** Former students of the institutions mentioned in a) who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the calendar year preceding the event.

All players nominated to teams by their national federations must be amateur golfers in accordance with the Rules of Amateur Status of the R&A Rules Limited and the United States Golf Association and have a handicap of nine or less when entering the World University Championship. Hcps of the players need to be confirmed by the National associations at inscription. Positive Hcps (better than 0) have a '+' in front of the number.

COMPETITION RULES

The Competitions of Golf will be run in accordance with the most recent Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited, the United States Golf Association and in accordance with the Local Rules approved by the FISU Technical Committee Chair.

FORMAT OF COMPETITION

The competitions shall last four days and include the following events:

- Men's team competition (72 holes stroke play)
- Women's team competition (72 holes stroke play)
- Men's individual competition (72 holes stroke play)
- Women's individual competition (72 holes stroke play)

The event will be played over 72 holes stroke-play: 18 holes each day for the four consecutive days of the event.

Each country may enter a maximum of six players and 5 officials.

In each event, each country may enter:

Men:

- Team event: the two best results each day shall count for the team classification per day
- Individual event: three players

Women:

- Team event: the two best results each day shall count for the team classification per day
- Individual event: three players.

Minimum of 36 Holes

In no circumstances will the Championship be extended beyond the fourth day. The winner will be the Team/Individual which returns the lowest score for the number of stipulated rounds played, except that, if it is not possible to play at least 36 holes, the Championship will be terminated without a Champion being determined.

PRACTICE ROUNDS

Practice round schedules will be allocated by the Championship Committee; requests for specific times/courses will not be accepted. Teams missing their assigned practice round times will not be permitted to play at another time unless there are exceptional circumstances, in which case any changes must be approved by the Committee in advance. Please note that it will not be considered exceptional circumstances if players/teams choose to travel on practice round days.

Further, if inclement weather causes delay or cancellation of a practice round, that round will not be re-scheduled

The Organizing Committee would like to emphasize already at this early stage the great importance of following the deadlines for the entries. Entries arriving after the expiration of the required deadlines will not be taken into consideration.

FISU REGISTRATION FEES

FISU shall receive from each competing country the following FISU registration fees:

- effective member associations of FISU: 20 EUR per athlete and official
- other associations: 40 EUR per athlete and official

These fees will be charged from the participating delegations by FISU.

PARTICIPATION FEES

Participation fees to the Organizing Committee (full board and event services):

- a participation fee of 80 EUR per person per night
- extra officials will pay a participation fee of 150 EUR per person per night

VISA REQUIREMENTS AND TRAVEL DOCUMETS **ACCEPTED BY FINLAND**

The Schengen member states have jointly agreed about the rules concerning the movement of thirdcountry nationals in their territories and decided which countries' citizens are required to present a visa. Furthermore, each Schengen State has decided which travel documents citizens of different third countries have to present upon entering the country.

Even if you did not need a visa to visit Finland, you need a valid passport or some other travel document accepted by Finland. It must be valid for at least ninety days after your intended date of departure from the Schengen area.

In addition, the passport or other travel document must have been issued no later than ten years ago.






ACCOMMODATION

Kuortane Olympic Training Center offers more than 800 beds in dormitories and in hotel which all are located within walking distance from the other Center's services and facilities.

All participants will be accommodated mainly in double rooms or in twin double rooms.















CATERING

All restaurants and cafés of the Center will serve the Championships. During the Championship week the Buffet Restaurant offers daily breakfast, lunch and dinner for all participants, officials and guests.

On competition days lunch will be served at the competition venue in Ruuhikoskigolf.













COMPETITION VENUE AND GOLF COURSE

The official trainings and competition will take place in Ruuhikoskigolf in Seinäjoki. Ruuhikoskigolf is one of the best golf courses in Nordic countries. The 18-hole course is designed by Robert Trent Jones Jr, and it was opened in 1992. The course requires precision more than it does length.

Ruuhikoskigolf has organized many major competitions, for example Finnish stroke-play Championship 2019 and European Men's Senior Team Championship 2006.

ACCREDITATION

The accreditation office will be at Kuortane Olympic Center/Athlete's Village. All participants must obtain accreditation from International Control Commission of FISU and from the Local Organizing Committee (LOC).

TRANSPORTATION

A bus/car transport for arriving and departing participants will be arranged from/to Vaasa international airport (VAA, 110 km/1h15 min.) or Seinäjoki train station (40 km/30 min.) to/from Kuortane according to their arrival and departure schedules received by 27th of July 2024 at the latest.
